

## Kelly Ayotte to Speak at December BMRC Meeting

BROOKLINE, NH December 19, 2009 -- The Brookline-Mason Republican Committee (BMRC) is very pleased to announce that Jennifer Horn will be speaking at the January 7 meeting, to be held at 7pm at the Brookline fire station. The BMRC meets at this time and location on the first Thursday of every month. In early October, Horn announced her candidacy for New Hampshire's Second District Congressional seat.
